Although TSIS continues through a period of rapid growth, we are determined to retain our 'big family' feel. We will always be a school where teachers know students by name and have a genuine interest in their holistic development.

In the last issue of our community newsletter, we outlined a series of imminent improvements to develop our school for current and future students. We are pleased to say that many of the facility upgrades have been completed or are well underway.

The main academic buildings at our Bearing Campus have been repainted and feedback has been overwhelmingly positive about their fresh, modern look. Upgrades to basketball and tennis courts have also been completed. Staged refurbishment of walkways, toilets and drainage systems is now more than 50% complete and the refurbishment of the sports hall (gymnasium) has commenced.

At our Wongwianyai Campus, the playground has been landscaped to maximise space for our young learners to play and learn outdoors. The new artificial grass looks amazing. The girls and boys love it and it highlights the beauty of our junior school building. Changes have also been made to our rapidly expanding Early Years' Centre and upgrades to the assembly hall are in the pipeline.

Our leadership team has been interviewing teachers since December for positions starting August 2023. We are now recruiting teachers through 'TES', the network used by leading international schools, and this will ensure that we employ the very best teachers for TSIS students. All teachers have been offered two-year contracts to best ensure continuity for our students as we continue through this exciting growth period.

From August, Visual Art and Geography will be added as options to our IGCSE, AS and A Level programmes. TSIS will also become a lead school in providing an innovative specialist STEAM programme (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics) for our Key Stage 1 and 2 students. The new programme will inspire in learners a love of Science!
