- 2.3 treat others with respect
- 2.4 obey the instructions of school staff
- 2.5 take care of property and the environment in and out of school
- 2.6 co-operate with other students and adults
- 2.7 complete work, homework and any assignments to the best of my ability
- 2.8 wear the TSIS uniform correctly at all times during the school day and on the journey to and from school
- 2.9 communicate in spoken English except when in language lessons
- 2.10 wear a conventional hairstyle and have no unorthodox piercings and/or tattoos
- 2.11 embrace different backgrounds and cultures in the schools international setting
- 2.12 responsible use of technology in compliance with school policies



3.0 As a parent of a student at TSIS I agree to:

- 3.1 support the Behaviour for Learning Policy of TSIS
- 3.2 advocate and support the school in the local community
- 3.3 ensure payment of all school fees according to school policy and deadlines
- 3.4 ensure respectful and polite communication with school staff, both written and verbal
- 3.5 share concerns about my child's education, welfare and behaviour with the school
- 3.6 respect the schools right to be the sole mediator of any incidents between students
- 3.7 proactively encourage and support your child's school work and achievements
- 3.8 respect and abide decisions made by the school
- 3.9 parents, who during the course of their participation, become a partied to confidential information, must agree not to divulge the information to any other person
- 3.10 attend all school meetings including parents' consultations and support school functions
- 3.11 ensure all meetings with teachers **MUST** be prearranged with the school office in advance.
Unannounced visits are not encouraged by the school
- 3.12 support the school in achieving a minimum 95% attendance rate for my child
- 3.13 inform the school of my child's absence
- 3.14 respond to all school communication by required deadlines
- 3.15 ensure my child arrives at school on time
- 3.16 avoid taking my child on holiday during term time
- 3.17 ensure my child has a full school uniform and can wear that uniform correctly including the correct PE attire
- 3.18 ensure my child has a conventional hairstyle and has no unorthodox piercings and/or tattoos
- 3.19 ensure my child has the time, space, encouragement and support to complete homework and all assignments to the best of his or her ability.
- 3.20 routinely monitor my child's use of technology and online activities
